

Application for renewal or extension of Exclusive Right of Burial

The Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial is issued for a set period. The Deed will state when the rights were issued, and for how long. (in perpetuity would mean a lifetime of 100 years.)

A Registered owner can apply to the Cemeteries Office at any time to extend the Right of Burial, as up to 100 years can be held.

To extend the Rights to a single grave within the dimensions of 9' x 4' the Registered owner can fill in and return this form to the Cemetery Office, with the original Deed or proof of purchase and the appropriate fee. The Deed will be endorsed and returned to you, together with your receipt for the fee paid.

For larger plots or family plots please contact the office for a quote.

Once the Rights have expired, the ownership reverts to the Burial Authority/Council. If the Rights to the grave have expired, you can still apply to re-purchase the grave using this application.
